Texas Natural History Collections (TNHC 86195). New county record (Ballinger et al. 2010. *Amphibians and Reptiles of Nebraska*. Rusty Lizard Press, Oro Valley, Arizona. 400 pp.; Fogell 2010. *A Field Guide to the Amphibians and Reptiles of Nebraska*. University of Nebraska-Lincoln, Lincoln, Nebraska. 158 pp.). Previous records exist to the east in Knox Co. and to the west in Keya Paha Co. Hatchling found dead on sandbar in river. Specimen collected under a Nebraska Game and Parks Commission Scientific and Educational Permit (# 293) to Drew R. Davis.
