

***ANOLIS CAROLINENSIS* (Green Anole)**. USA: TEXAS: BROOKS Co.: 316 W Blucher, Falfurrias (ca. 27.22451°N, 98.14810°W; WGS 84). 16 March 1969. Irene Escalante. Verified by Travis J. LaDuc. Biodiversity Collections, The University of Texas at Austin (TNHC 115925 [DRD 8031]). One adult individual was discovered in the former University of Texas–Pan American collection and the locality was georeferenced using Google Earth. This specimen represents a new county record (Dixon 2013. *Amphibians and Reptiles of Texas: with Keys, Taxonomic Synopses, Bibliography, and Distribution Maps*. Third edition. Texas A&M University Press, College Station, Texas. viii + 447 pp.) and expands the species' recognized distribution in south Texas westward. *Anolis carolinensis* is known from adjacent Jim Wells, Hidalgo, Kenedy, and Kleberg counties (Dixon 2013, *op. cit.*; Guadiana et al. 2020. *Herpetol. Rev.* 51:799–803), and the nearest known specimen record is ca. 36.6 km to the east-southeast in Kenedy County (TNHC 114543; Guadiana et al. 2020, *op. cit.*).

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
